**Care Requirements:**

**Temperature Range:** 32-80°F

**Water Hardness:** Medium to Hard

**Type of Tank Setup:** Freshwater (cold) or Freshwater (tropical) / Species or Community

**Food:** Live, or Frozen (may acclimate to flake)

**Swimming level:** Bottom

**Special Requirements:** These fish, although they are minnows, act like darters. They need to feed off the bottom as darters do.

**Spawning:** Occurs from July-August. Little is known about the spawning behavior.

**Notes:** Great community fish!! Likes to roam around the bottom of the tank, sucking food off of the bottom. This fish may be great for a sand-bottom tank as its rooting habits may keep the sand clean.
